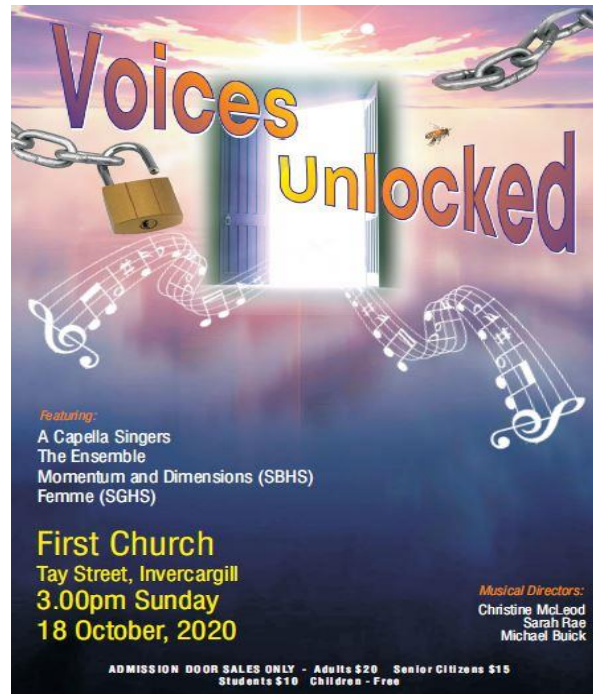
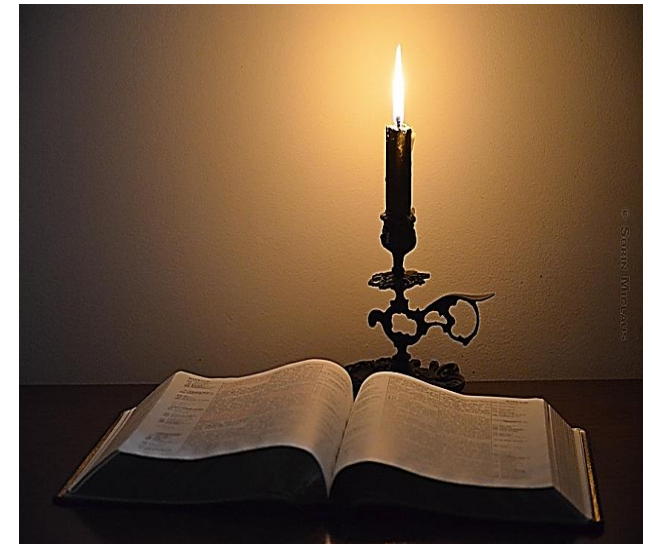


PRAYER NEEDS:
